


Between 1873 and 1934

They gathered at the Red Star Line buildings, in the old harbour








For medical inspection and desinfection of their luggage






For embarkation to the new world and to a new life





The Belgenland II was the largest ship ever seen in Antwerp at that time








Immigrants new life started often at Ellis Island (New York)

In the old harbour, in the recently developed neighbourhood the "Eilandje", nearby the MAS






